NEW MODEL JIG

Since the last newsletter, we have released a new model of the Gifkins Dovetail Jig. The new model is designed around a custom aluminium extrusion, making it that much sturdier and even more reliable. It also comes standard with a second sliding stop, a great extra tool for those into boxmaking. The template specifications remain the same, producing those tight and clean joints that have become synonymous with the Gifkins Dovetail Jig.



The template mounting has changed with the new model so if you are ordering any template upgrades we need to know which model you have. We will continue to stock all the profiles for both models.

The Old Model Jig (with high density fibre block) takes a template with 5 countersunk mounting holes. This template suits all jigs sold before March 2006

The New Model Jig (with aluminium block) takes a template with 2 countersunk mounting holes. This template suits all jigs sold after 1st March 2006.

OLD BLOCKS - \$69

We still have a small number of the old style blocks for those customers wishing to have a designated block for each of their (older style) templates. These blocks have been discounted to \$69 plus \$11 postage, but only while stocks last. This price is the block only, set up with Backing Boards, Shim and locating pins, but without any stops.

FINGER JOINT UPGRADES - \$173

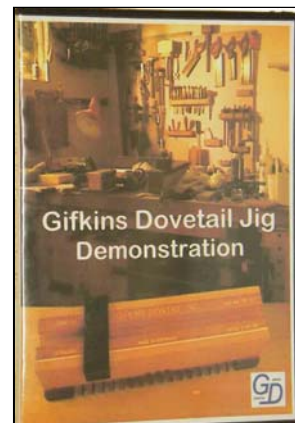


The much awaited finger joint template is now available, with templates to suit both the new and old models of the Gifkins Dovetail Jig. The F5 template cuts a joint with delicate 5 mm fingers, and is fully adjustable, maintaining the quality and accuracy that is synonymous with products from Gifkins Dovetail. It can be purchased as a complete package or as a template upgrade for those that already have a Gifkins Dovetail Jig.

The template uses a specially designed solid carbide cutter made by Carb-I-Tool in Melbourne, and will handle any thickness up to 13 mm. It is hoped to release a "Big Brother" to this template next year for thicker timber. To get the best results the template is used with 2 stops on the jig, which come as standard on the new model. For those customers with the old model and only 1 stop, it is recommended that you purchase a second stop with the template upgrade. Extra stops are available for \$29.

DEMONSTRATION DVD - \$19

A detailed Demonstration DVD is also now available to take you through all the situations you might encounter when dovetailing. A chapter for the finger joints will be added later this year. This DVD is much more comprehensive than the previous Demo Video and is a must for those that want to get the most out of their jig. It goes for 75 minutes with loads of information.



BOXMAKING DVD'S - \$39 each

We now have 2 DVD's on boxmaking projects, with more in the pipeline.

#1 takes you through the sliding lid project which is a good introduction to small joinery. This DVD covers the same project as the old video and is a useful addition to the #1 boxmaking plans.

#2 is the loose-lidded project from the 'Dovetailed Boxes' plans – another good project for developing your skills.

CLAMP HOLDERS - \$6 PAIR

Roger has designed a clamp holder that fits under the knob on the jig, for use with Bessey's Kliklamps. This holder locates the clamp in the correct position and also holds it at the correct height, safely above the cutter.



BESSEY CLAMPS - \$42

We also sell Bessey Kliklamps (made in Germany), as they are by far the best clamps I have used with the jig. These are a quick action clamp with a very positive action and a light weight magnesium alloy head.



REDUCING COLLETS - \$14

Roger has had some 1/2" to 1/4" reducing collets specially made to his own design. These collets are 32 mm long overall, giving much more clamping length than regular collets, resulting in a more secure hold on the cutter. They also have a flange at the top so they can't drop down inside the chuck on the router. This ensures the cutter is held at the optimum height. The flange also makes it much easier to remove the collet from the router!

These collets are a great improvement on the regular collets that come with most routers.



BIG BEARINGS FOR REBATE CUTTER - \$8

We now have a supply of 19mm bearings for the rebate cutter to reduce the depth of cut to 1.6mm. This is especially useful in highly figured or fiddle-back timbers to give the cleanest possible cut. The idea is to cut a shallow rebate with the big bearing and then change to the smaller bearing to increase the depth of the rebate.

NEW JEWELLERY BOX PLANS

Roger is currently working on a new set of plans, this time for an elaborate jewellery box with lift out tray and fittings. It is a beautiful but also functional project, making an ideal gift for that special person... These plans should be available in the second half of this year, with an anticipated DVD to accompany them. Keep a watch on the website for availability. 4. Slot cutter



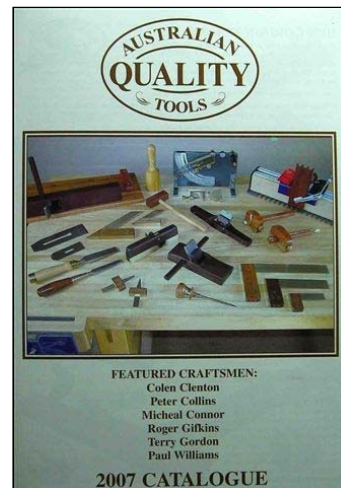

A group of Australian toolmakers and craftsmen have combined to produce a 16 page colour catalogue of their products. Featured craftsmen include:

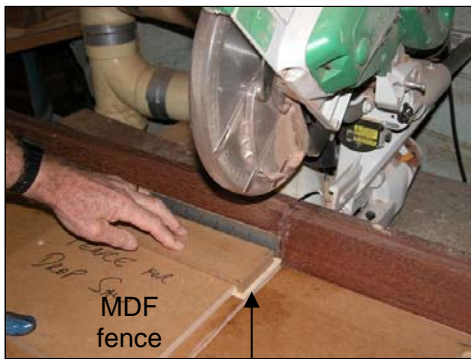

DROP SAW TABLE AND FENCE

The plans for my custom fence are now available on the web site. The thing I really like about this set up is the ease and safety when handling small work pieces. With boxmaking I am often working with pieces only 15 or 20 mm wide, and I had always found it difficult to trim these to width cleanly, accurately and safely, especially on the saw bench! This set up allows me to trim pieces so that the sides are exactly parallel no matter how narrow they are, whilst keeping my fingers well clear of the blade with a hold down. See photo:

This idea revolves around the square MDF fence on the left of the photo. If you start with a piece of MDF and trim one edge on the drop saw, then, even if the drop saw is not set up exactly square to the back fence, you will get perfectly parallel edges when trimming to width against this MDF, as the MDF is now exactly parallel to the blade. By using a hold down as shown you can work with tiny workpieces without compromising accuracy or safety.

DOVETAIL JIG PACKAGES

With the addition of the Finger Joint template, it was necessary to change our packaging details. "The Lot" package now has 7 templates (up from 6 previously), and we have introduced a "Premium" package with 4 templates, one from each series. The smaller packages remain the same but now have a greater choice of template profiles.
