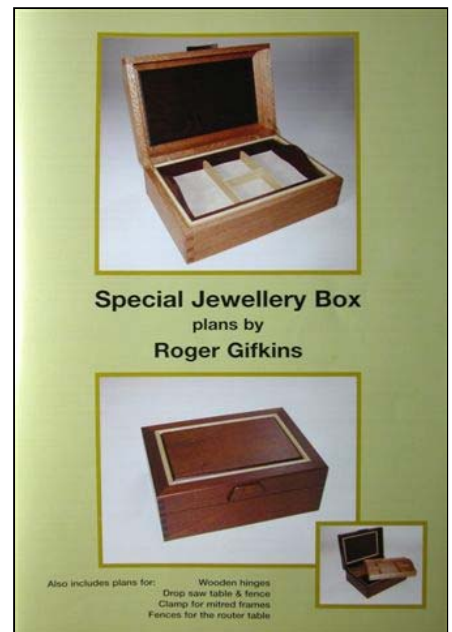
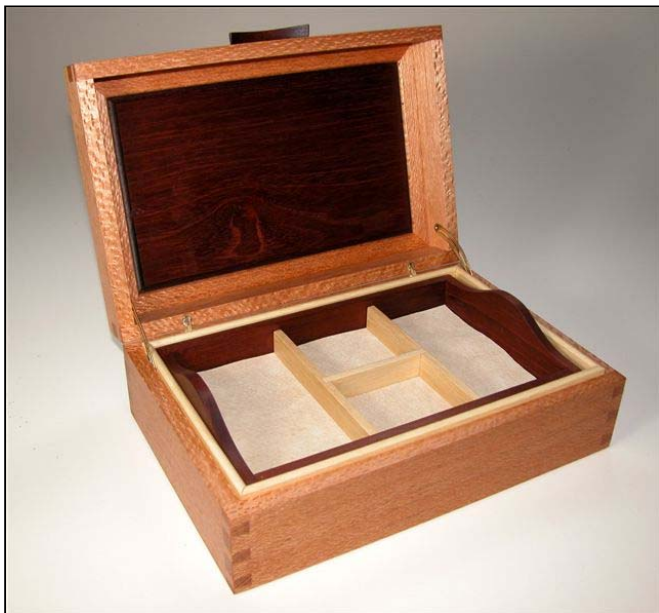


PLANS #3 "SPECIAL JEWELLERY BOX"



Roger's new "Special Jewellery Box" plans describe the elaborate jewellery box shown in the photo above. This box features a dovetailed carcass (it could be finger joints), which is split in half to form the lid. The top is a mitred frame with floating panel, which is glued down to the dovetailed carcass. The box uses concealed barrel hinges which are incredibly easy to fit. An internal lining locates the lid and support a lift out dovetailed tray with shaped handles and loose partitions. Photo shows a box in Silky Oak with Red Cedar panel and tray.

This is an ideal project as a special gift.

The plans cover all the processes in making this jewellery box, and give cutting lists for a small and a large version of the box. They also include appendices which cover:

- Wooden Hinges, single action and double action
- Drop saw table and fence
- Clamp for mitred frames
- Fences for the router table

BOXMAKING DVD #3 140 min

Roger's 3rd DVD on the "Special Jewellery Box" project (above) covers all the joinery in superb detail. Recorded over 2 full days of Roger making the complete project, the DVD is condensed down to 2 hrs 20 min without losing any steps or techniques. Packed full of tips and hints, with voice overs to reinforce safety and important points, this DVD makes an important addition to the written plans.

With the plans, DVD and both sets of boxmaking cutters you can complete this elaborate jewellery box for that special gift.

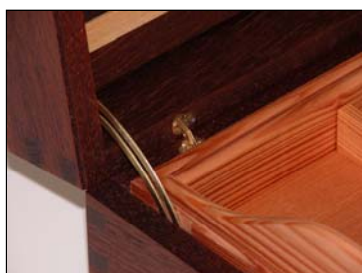


Photo shows detail of hinge and corner stay in a Red Cedar box.
