Drawer making with Neil Scobie

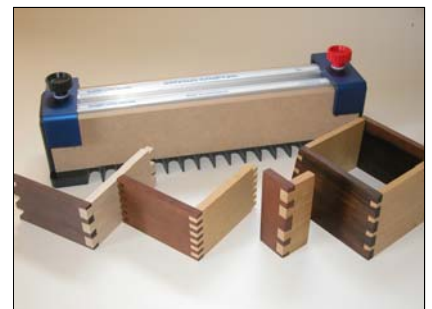
